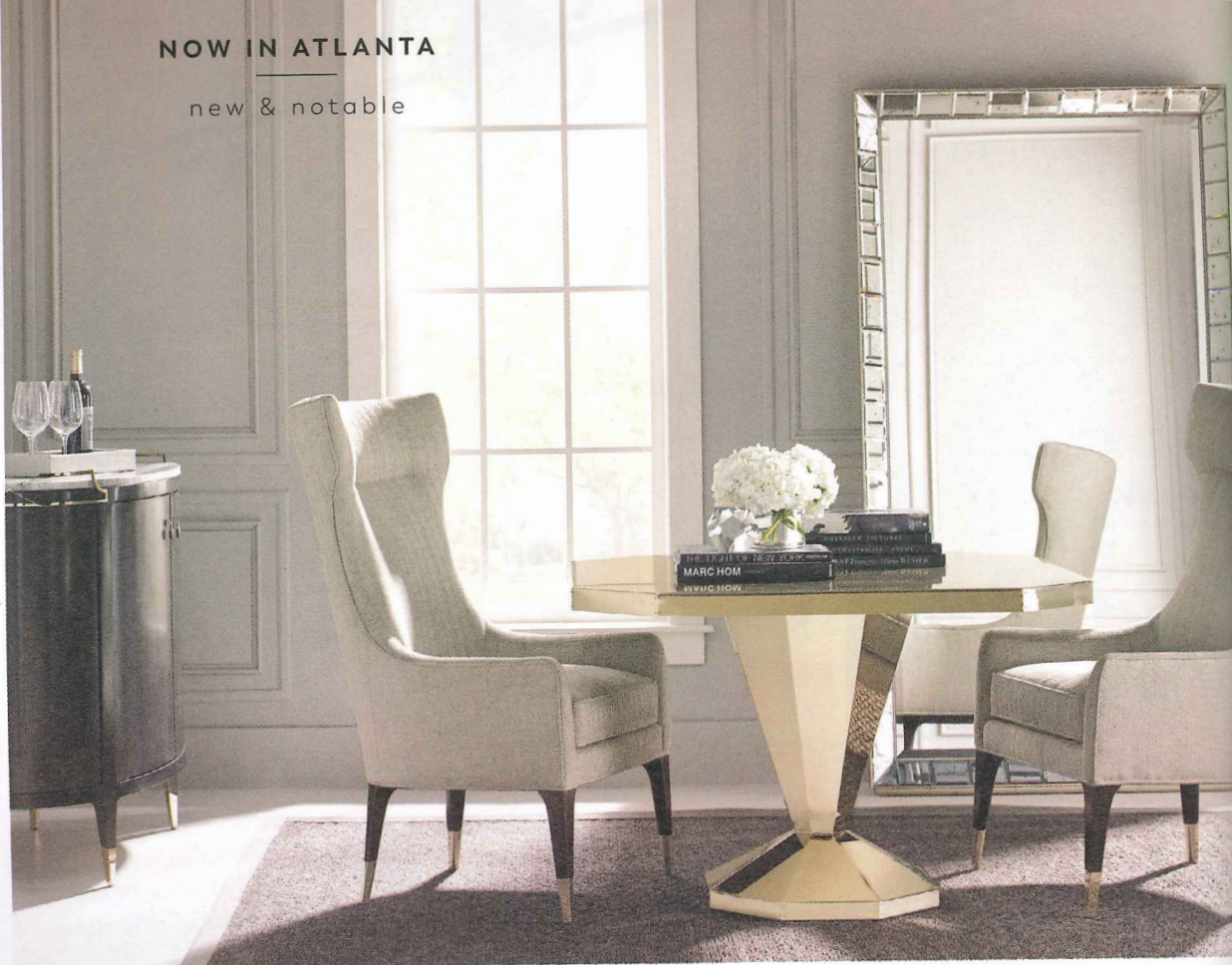

Caracole, the Greensboro, N.C.-based furniture showroom, arrived at AmericasMart with great fanfare earlier this year. Its name is an homage to dressage—a move in which the horse turns elegantly. And it's fitting for both the brand's furniture and its overall showroom—the fashion-forward, glamorous pieces (names like *Finesse*, *What's New Pussycat?* and *Extrav-agate* are memorable) will most certainly feel at home in Atlanta's most elegant abodes. SOME BUNNY CHIC

For anyone established in the design game, chances are you've taken inspiration from **Bunny Williams** at one point or another. The Virginia-born designer—who cut her teeth working for giants like *Sister Parish*—has been inspiring younger generations for decades, especially with the introduction of her own line, *Bunny Williams Home*, in 2008. Fast-forward nine years, and Williams' signature combination of comfort and elegance has

manifested itself in the continuation of her home line, which showed at High Point Market this year after a five-year hiatus from market. The 20 new items added to the cumulative 200 options were worth the wait. There's the lovely Greek key Ellsworth bed (from \$10,750); the swoonworthy gold drapery-style Arabella mirror (\$3,200); and the must-have Parker sofa (from \$6,500), all inspired by pieces Williams has in her own home. The good news is that you can now source Williams' chic pieces locally, thanks to Mathews Furniture + Design, who will now carry the line for the first time. Says buyer and interior designer Nina Nash, "It's superexciting to be carrying Bunny Williams Home at Mathews—I've had my eye on this line for years now!
